CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Mary C. June, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well (Well No. 8), pump and distribution system for quasi-municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 27, T.21N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 27 bears N. 86°46'04" E., a distance of 1,880 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Source:	Underground (Well No. 8)
Manner of use:	Quasi-Municipal
Amount of appropriation:	*0.10 c.f.s., but not to exceed 69.3 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	**March 24, 1961

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 701 feet deep, 14-inch diameter casing, equipped with a 75 H.P. G. E. motor, Johnston pump and totalizing meter, thence through a distribution system for quasi-municipal water service to Washoe County's Lemmon Valley water customers within the place of use approved under the permit as depicted by record (map and legal description), which is filed in the Office of the State Engineer, being the Lemmon Valley Water Service Area as it existed at the time of the filing of Application 55936.

*The total combined duty of water under Permit 55936, Certificate 17885; Permit 55937, Certificate 14257; Permit 55938, Certificate 14258; Permit 55939, Certificate 15080; Permit 55940, Certificate 14259; Permit 55941, Certificate 15081; Permit 55942, Certificate 14260; Permit 59601, Permit 61150, Permit 61588, Certificate 17886; Permit 61590, Certificate 17887; and Permits 66543, 66544, 66853, 66956, 66957, 67013, 67014, 68089, 68090, 68716, 69061, 69062, 69588, 71414, 71415, 71231, 71232, 73636, 73637, 73638, and 73639 shall not exceed 1,259.6681 acre-feet annually.

**This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of Permit 48650, which changed the place of use of Permit 27234, Certificate 8793, which changed the place of use of Permit 19690, Certificate 6416; therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 19690, Certificate 6416.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
