

STATE OF NEVADA**CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, Linda J. Kelly, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Winter's Mine Spring #3, an unimproved spring, for wildlife purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 26, T.12N., R.22E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 26, bears S. 32°02' E., a distance of 4,310.85 feet situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Source:	Winter's Mine Spring #3
Manner of use:	Wildlife
Amount of appropriation:	0.0005 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 75 deer
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	*February 17, 2010

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:


The natural discharge from Winter's Mine Spring #3 flows down the natural channel where 75 deer water within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 26, T.12N., R.22E., M.D.B.&M.

***The date of priority was established in accordance with NRS 533.395(3) by the cancellation rescission hearing of September 17, 2010.**

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
