

STATE OF NEVADA**CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, Alan Glaser, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump, and trough for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE¹/₄ NE¹/₄ Section 10, T.37N., R.57E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 10 bears N. 63°53'00" E., a distance of 787.38 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Manner of use:	Stockwater
Amount of appropriation:	0.01 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 100 head of cattle
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	December 13, 2001


Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well of unknown depth, 6-inch diameter casing, equipped with a 3/4 H.P. submersible pump, motor and a 4,000 gallon holding tank, thence gravity fed to a single trough where 100 head of cattle water within the NE¹/₄ NE¹/₄ Section 10, T.37N., R.57E., M.D.B.&M., being within the North Fork Group Grazing Allotment.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
