

STATE OF NEVADA**CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, George G. Lindesmith, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an unnamed, improved spring, spring box and hose for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

Within Government Tract 48-C, T.16S., R.56E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the northwest corner of said Government Tract 48-C bears N. 68°18'07" W., a distance of 948.23 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Source:	Unnamed Spring
Manner of use:	Irrigation
Amount of appropriation:	0.0045 c.f.s., but not to exceed 3.22 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	April 6, 2006


Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from an unnamed spring by a spring box and hose for the irrigation of 0.644 acres located within Government Tract 48-C T.16S., R.56E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit with the understanding that the total annual duty of water shall not exceed 5.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
