CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Jim C. Estill, Permittee, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well (Muttleberry Well), pump troughs, and pond for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 10, T.26N., R.33E., M.D.B.& M., or at a point from which the N $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 10 bears N. 79°07'45" W., a distance of 1,950.57 feet, situated in Pershing County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator:	James C. Estill
Source:	Underground (Muttleberry Well)
Manner of use:	Stockwater
Amount of appropriation:	*0.0046 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 150 head of cattle, but not to exceed 3.36 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1 st to December 31 st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	April 23, 1985

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 125 feet deep, equipped with a submersible pump and generator, thence to two (2) troughs and a pond where 150 head of cattle water within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 10, T.26N., R.33E., M.D.B.& M., being within the Rochester Common Allotment.

*The total combined duty of water under Permit 49005, Certificate 17910, and Permit 49006, Certificate 17911, shall not exceed the amount sufficient to water 150 head of cattle.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
