CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Robert E. Firth, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Steamboat Creek for instream flow purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

Candler Ditch

NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 33, T.18N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.


*This certificate changes the manner and place of use of portions of Claims 702, 703, 704, 705 and 706, Truckee River Final Decree, United States v. Orr Water Ditch Co., In Equity Docket No. A-3 (D. Nevada 1944), therefore, the dates of priority remain the same as Claims 702, 703, 704, 705 and 706.

Any application to change the manner of use of this certificate will be subject to additional determination and evaluation with respect to effects on existing rights and the resource.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and specifically subject to the continuing jurisdiction and regulation by the Federal Water Master and the State Engineer.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
