

THE STATE OF NEVADA**CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, Jim Estill, Permittee, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Grayson Spring (an unimproved spring), for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

Lot 3, Section 5, T.26N., R.37E., M.D.B.& M. (unsurveyed), or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 5 bears N. 78°49' W., a distance of 1,769.0 feet, situated in Pershing County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

The natural discharge from Grayson Spring, (an unimproved spring) flows through the natural channel where 770 head of cattle water within Lot 3, Section 5, T.26N., R.37E., M.D.B.&M., being within the Rochester Common Allotment.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
