

**C O R R E C T E D   C E R T I F I C A T E****STATE OF NEVADA****CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

**WHEREAS**, Don Springmeyer, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from the Truckee River for wildlife purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

**Largomarsino-Murphy (South Side) Ditch**

**NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 18, T.19N., R.21E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 18 bears N. 42°45' E., a distance of 3,018.0 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.**

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

**Water flows in the natural channel of the Truckee River for wildlife purposes from the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 18, T.19N., R.21E., M.D.B.&M., downstream to the inlet of Pyramid Lake, Washoe and Storey Counties, Nevada**


**\*This certificate changes the manner and place of use of Claim 622, Truckee River Final Decree, United States v. Orr Water Ditch Co., In Equity Docket No. A-3 (D. Nevada 1944),**

therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Claim 622.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and specifically subject to the continuing jurisdiction and regulation by the Federal Water Master and the State Engineer.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
