## CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

**WHEREAS**, Deborah G. Sotero, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well (View Street Well), pump and distribution system for municipal and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

**SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 6, T.19N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E $\frac{1}{4}$  corner of said Section 6 bears N. 38°28'29" E., a distance of 2,845.82 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.**

**Under the provisions of NRS 533.425**, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

**Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:**

**Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 530 feet deep, 18-inch diameter casing, equipped with a 350 H.P. pump and totalizing meter, thence into Truckee Meadows Water Authority's water distribution system.**

The overall system ultimately conveys the water to Truckee Meadows Water Authority's water customers within its certified water service area. Said service area is depicted by record (map and legal description) which is filed with the State Engineer's office.

\*This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 20371, Certificate 6116, therefore the date of priority remains the same as Permit 20371, Certificate 6116.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and to the terms and conditions stated in the State Engineer's Order 1161, dated May 16, 2000.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
