CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Bruce R. Scott, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for quasi-municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 35, T.17N., R.23E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 35 bears N. 60°45'49" W., a distance of 3,046.05 feet situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Manner of use:	Quasi-Municipal
Amount of appropriation:	0.005 c.f.s., but not to exceed 1.68 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	*February 12, 1971

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 140 feet deep, 8-inch diameter casing, equipped with a 3/4 H.P. Flint and Walling submersible pump and motor, totalizing meter and pressure tank, thence through a distribution system for quasi-municipal water service to a storage/shop building with office, kitchen and restroom facilities located within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 35, T.17N., R.23E., M.D.B.&M.

*This certificate changes the point of diversion of Permit 61465, which changed the point of diversion, manner and place of use of a portion of Permit 30833, Certificate 9577, which changed the point of diversion of a portion of Permit 29964, which changed the point of diversion of Permit 25966; therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 25966.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
