CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Gregory M. Bilyeu, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from the Truckee River through the Steamboat Canal for as decreed purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE¹/₄ SW¹/₄ Section 31, T.19N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 31, bears S. 62°04' E., a distance of 3,195.0 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from the Truckee River through the Steamboat Canal, thence to a screened settling basin, pipeline, and ditches for flood irrigation of 1.0 acre of pasture and garden located within a portion of the NE¹/₄ SE¹/₄ of Section 16, T.19N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M., being further described as within a portion of Assessor's Parcel Number 038-133-01, Washoe County, Nevada.
