CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, John R. Langford, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Sulfur Spring for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 24, T.9N., R.24E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 24 bears S. 89°47' W., a distance of 193 feet situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Manner of use:	Stockwater
Amount of appropriation:	0.000625 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 20 head of cattle, but not to exceed 0.45 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	February 27, 2004

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

The discharge from Sulfur Spring flows through the natural channel into a pond impounded by an earthen dam where 20 head of cattle water within E $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 23, T.9N., R.24E., M.D.B. & M., being further described as Assessor's Parcel Number 10-781-02, Lyon County, Nevada.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

Certificate No. **17985**

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
