

STATE OF NEVADA**CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, William A. Nisbet, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, (Well No. 8), pump and distribution system for quasi-municipal and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 9, T.21N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 9 bears S. 16°08'35" E., a distance of 1,178.52 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Source:	Underground (Well No. 8)
Manner of use:	Quasi-Municipal and Domestic
Amount of appropriation:	*2.0 c.f.s., but not to exceed 436.86 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	**June 7, 1966

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 350 feet deep, 16-inch diameter casing, equipped with a 150 H.P. Caterpillar diesel engine, pump, and totalizing meter, thence through a distribution system for quasi-municipal and domestic water service to Utilities Inc. of Nevada's Cold Springs Valley water customers within the place of use approved under the permit as depicted by record (map and legal description), which is filed in the Office of the State Engineer, being the Cold Springs Water Service Area as it existed at the time of the filing of Application 65046.

*The total combined duty of water from Long Valley (100A) and Cold Springs Valley (100) under Permit 65038, Certificate 17994; Permits 65039, 65040, 65042, 65043, 65044, 65045, Permit 65046, Certificate 17995; Permits 65047, 65048, 65049, 65050, 65051, 65052, 65053, 65054, 65055, 65056, Permit 65057, Certificate 17996; Permit 65058, Certificate 17997; Permit 65059, Certificate 17998; and Permits 74135 and 75444 shall not exceed 2,414.86 acre-feet annually.

*The total combined duty of water from Long Valley (100A) under Permits 65042, 65043, 65044, 65045, 65056, Permit 65057, Certificate 17996; Permit 65058, Certificate 17997; Permit 65059, Certificate 17998; and Permit 75444 shall not exceed 1,906.90 acre-feet annually.


*The total combined duty of water from Cold Springs Valley (100) under Permit 65038, Certificate 17994; Permits 65039, 65040, Permit 65046, Certificate 17995; Permits 65047, 65048, 65049, 65050, 65051, 65052, 65053, 65054, 65055 and 74135 shall not exceed 1,707.96 acre-feet annually.

**This certificate changes the place of use of Permit 59158, which changed the place of use of Permit 53087, which changed the place of use of Permit 52632, which changed the place of use of Permit 51203, which changed the place of use of Permit 49518, which changed the place of use of Permit 39848, which changed the place of use of Permit 23171, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 23171.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
