

THE STATE OF NEVADA**CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, Mark Dean, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well (Big Flat Well), pump, tank, trough and pond for wildlife purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE¼ NE¼ Section 34, T.31N., R.60E., M.D.B.& M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 34 bears N. 59°13'20" E., a distance of 808.95 feet, situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator:	U.S.D.I., Bureau of Land Management
Source:	Underground (Big Flat Well)
Manner of use:	Wildlife
Amount of appropriation:	0.014 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 25 antelope, but not to exceed 0.112 acre feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	September 21, 1993

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 100 feet deep, 6-inch diameter casing, equipped with a submersible pump and 5,000-gallon storage tank, thence to a trough and pond where 25 antelope water in the NE¼ NE¼ Section 34, T.31N., R.60E., M.D.B.& M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.



The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
