CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Robert E. Firth, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from the Truckee River through the Lake Ditch, for as decreed purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

Lake Ditch

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 19, T.19N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., or at point from which the NE corner of said Section 19 bears S. 88°05'00" E., a distance of 2,620.00 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from the Truckee River via the Lake Ditch, head gate, lateral and storage pond, thence pumped through a distribution system, including a holding tank, for sprinkler landscape irrigation of 1.14 acres within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 7, T.18N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., and 0.30 acres within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 12, T.18N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M. (1.44 acres total), being further described as within a portion of Assessor's Parcel Number 043-062-08, Washoe County, Nevada.

*The total combined duty of water under Permit 66974, Certificate 17142 and Permit 66975, Certificate 18104, shall not exceed 9.85 acre-feet as decreed for the irrigation of 2.53 acres.

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
****This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 12338, Certificate 3649, which changed the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Claim 408, Truckee River Final Decree, in United States v. Orr Water Ditch Co., In Equity Docket No. A-3 (D. Nevada 1944), therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Claim 408.**

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed the 4.0 acre-feet per acre as decreed from any and/or all sources and subject to the continuing jurisdiction and regulation by the Federal Water Master and State Engineer.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.


