CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Shannon Daines, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for quasi-municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW¹/₄ SW¹/₄ Section 14, T.19S., R.60E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 14 bears S. 36°52'22" W., a distance of 885.36 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation:	*0.014 c.f.s., but not to exceed 10.0 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 600 feet deep, 8-inch diameter casing, equipped with a 5 H.P. Red Jacket submersible pump, totalizing meter, and four (4) pressure tanks, thence through a distribution system for quasi-municipal water service for watering of horses, irrigation of approximately 1.5 acres of pasture and approximately 250 landscape trees, located within a portion of the SW¹/₄ SW¹/₄ Section 14, T.19S., R.60E., M.D.B.&M., being further described as Assessor's Parcel Numbers 125-14-404-001 and 125-14-404-002, Clark County, Nevada.


*The total combined duty of water under Permit 65814, Certificate 18269 and Permit 67832, Certificate 18270 shall not exceed 12.19 acre-feet annually.

**This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 24582, Certificate 7673; which changed the point of diversion and place of use of Permit 13386, Certificate 3949; therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 13386, Certificate 3949.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
