CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, George G. Lindesmith, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well (MCO Well #2), pump, and distribution system for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 5, T.22N., R.21E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 5 bears N. 66°17'59" E., a distance of 2,969.86 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 651 feet deep, 12-inch diameter casing, equipped with a Johnson deep-well turbine pump, 150 H.P. motor and totalizing meter, thence through a distribution system for pivot sprinkler irrigation of the following land:

0.24 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 32, T.23N., R.21E., M.D.B.&M.
13.07 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 32, T.23N., R.21E., M.D.B.&M.
3.55 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 32, T.23N., R.21E., M.D.B.&M.
0.34 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 5, T.22N., R.21E., M.D.B.&M.
0.17 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 5, T.22N., R.21E., M.D.B.&M.
7.66 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 5, T.22N., R.21E., M.D.B.&M.
3.21 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 5, T.22N., R.21E., M.D.B.&M.
0.34 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 5, T.22N., R.21E., M.D.B.&M.
0.12 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 5, T.22N., R.21E., M.D.B.&M.
28.70 Total acres

The total combined duty of water under Permit 57085, Certificate 14078; Permit 57086, Certificate 14032; Permit 57087, Certificate 14033; Permit 57088, Certificate 14034; Permit 57089, Certificate 14035; Permit 57095, Certificate 14041; Permit 58507, Certificate 14042; Permit 58508, Certificate 14043; Permit 58509, Certificate 14044 and permit 75473, Certificate 18348 shall not exceed 519.96 acre-feet annually.

*This certificate changes the place of use of a portion of Permit 53303, Certificate 12897; which changed the point of diversion of a portion of Permit 49711, which changed the place of use of Permit 37019, which changed the point of diversion, manner and place of use of a portion of Permit 20308, Certificate 6015; therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 20308, Certificate 6015.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit with the understanding that the total annual duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
