CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Mary Crawley, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well (Spring Creek Well #7), pump and distribution system for municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW¹ NW¹ Section 8, T.20N., R.21E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 8 bears N. 6°11'27" W., a distance of 1,050.15 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation:	*0.054 c.f.s., but not to exceed 38.08 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	**March 11, 1975

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 710 feet deep, 16-inch diameter casing, equipped with a 350 H. P. U. S. motor, pump and totalizing meter, thence through a distribution system for municipal water service to Washoe County's water customers within the place of use approved under the permit as depicted by record (map and legal description), which is filed in the office of the State Engineer, being the Spanish Springs Valley Water Service area as it existed at the time of the filing of Application 67945.

*The total combined duty of water under Permit 67943, Permit 67944, and Permit 67945, Certificate 18474; shall not exceed 38.08 acre-feet annually.

**This certificate changes the point of diversion, manner and place of use of a portion of Permit 60545, which changed the place of use of a portion of Permit 29261, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 29261.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
