CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Mary Crawley, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well (Lightning W Well #1), pump and distribution system for municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW¹/₄ SE¹/₄ Section 22, T.16N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 22 bears S. 48° 53' 27" E., a distance of 2,340.40 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator:	Washoe County
Source:	Underground (Lightning W Well #1, aka Reservoir Well)
Manner of use:	Municipal
Amount of appropriation:	*0.0188 c.f.s., but not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st through December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	**January 14, 1977

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 400 feet deep, 8-inch diameter casing, equipped with a Hayes submersible pump, 20 H.P. Franklin motor and totalizing meter, thence through a distribution system for municipal water service to Washoe County's water customers within the place of use approved under the permit as depicted by record (map and legal description), which is filed in the Office of the State Engineer; otherwise known as Washoe County's West Washoe Valley Service Area as it existed at the time of the filing of Application 70114.

*The total combined duty of water under Permit 61627, Permit 61628, Permit 61629, Certificate 18626; Permit 61724, Certificate 18627; Permit 62348, Permit 70114, Certificate 18628; Permit 70865, Permit 70866, Permit 76548 and Permit 76549 shall not exceed 223.60 acre-feet annually.

**This certificate changes the point of diversion, manner and place of use of a portion of Permit 57741, which changed the point of diversion, manner and place of use of a portion of Permit 52002, Certificate 12402; which changed the place of use of Permit 30999; therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 30999.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
