CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Paul Plouviez, Permittee, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Spire Canyon Spring for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 19, T.20N., R.36E., or at a point from which the W $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 19, bears S. 69°20' W., a distance of 2,360.00 feet situated in Churchill County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator:	Paul Plouviez
Source:	Spire Canyon Spring
Manner of use:	Stockwater
Amount of appropriation:	0.0063 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 200 head of cattle but not to exceed 4.48 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1 st through December 31 st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	April 13, 2007

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:


Water is diverted from Spire Canyon Spring via a shallow, covered excavated hole, thence through 50 feet of 1-inch diameter pipe to a trough where 200 head of cattle water within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 19, T.20N., R.36E., M.D.B. & M., being within the Dixie Valley Grazing Allotment.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
