CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Mary Crawley, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well (S.T.M.G.I.D. Well #1), pump and distribution system for municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE¼ NE¼ Section 19, T.18N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 19 bears N. 85° 17' 58" E., a distance of 645.49 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 530 feet deep, 12-inch diameter casing, equipped with a Pumptron pump, 125 H.P. General Electric motor and totalizing meter, thence through a distribution system for municipal water service to Washoe County's/South Truckee Meadows General Improvement District's (S.T.M.G.I.D.) water customers within the place of use approved under the permit as depicted by record (map and legal description), which is filed in the Office of the State Engineer; otherwise known as the S.T.M.G.I.D.'s Service Area as it existed at the time of the filing of Application 58929.

***The total combined duty of water under Permit 58929, Certificate 18713 and Permit 58930, Certificate 18714 shall not exceed 8.0 acre-feet annually.**

**This certificate changes the manner and place of use of Permit 54287, which changed the point of diversion and place of use of Permit 48062, which changed the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 31320; therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 31320.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
