

STATE OF NEVADA**CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, Harry L. Louft, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a mine shaft, pump and distribution system for domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE¹/₄ SW¹/₄ Section 5, T.26S., R.64E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 5 bears S. 44°10' W., a distance of 2,418 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation:	0.0023 c.f.s., but not to exceed 0.13 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st through December 31st of each year

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a mine shaft, solar-powered submersible Kyocera pump, 325 gallon storage tank and totalizing meter, thence through pipeline to one home for domestic purposes located within a portion of the NE¹/₄ SW¹/₄ Section 5, T.26S., R.64E., M.D.B.&M., being further described as within a portion of Assessor's Parcel Number 228-05-000-003, Clark County, Nevada.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
