CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, G. Robert Deiro, Permittee, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for quasi-municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW¹/₄ NE¹/₄ Section 15, T. 19S., R. 60E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the C¹/₄ corner of said Section 15 bears S. 47°11'00" W., a distance of 1,583.0 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Manner of use:	Quasi-Municipal
Amount of appropriation:	*0.011 c.f.s., but not to exceed 1.5 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st through December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	**May 27, 1953

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 500 feet deep, 8-inch diameter casing, equipped with a 3.0 H.P. Hayes submersible pump, three (3) pressure tanks and totalizing meter, thence through a distribution system for a single family residence, guest home, swimming pool and associated landscaping located within the SW¹/₄ NE¹/₄ Section 15, T. 19S., R. 60E., M.D.B.&M., being further described as Assessor's Parcel Number 125-15-602-010, Clark County, Nevada.

*The total combined duty of water under Permit 68508, Certificate 16814 and Permit 79203, Certificate 19067 shall not exceed 3.5 acre-feet annually.

**This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 74978, Certificate 17347; which changed the point of diversion and place of use of Permit 15083, Certificate 4490; therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 15083, Certificate 4490.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
