CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, William A. Nisbet, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well (Basque Well #2), pump, tank and troughs for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE¼ NW¼ Section 16, T.29N., R.60E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the NE corner of Section 3, T.29N., R.60E., M.D.B. & M., bears N. 35°19' E., a distance of 15,381.7 feet, situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: TI Ranches, LLC

Source: Underground (Basque Well #2)

Manner of use: Stockwater

Amount of appropriation: *0.0218 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 300 head of cattle and 2000 head of sheep, but not to exceed 15.68 acre-feet annually.

Period of use: January 1st through December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: **April 7, 1981

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 116 feet deep, 6 inch diameter casing, equipped with a Jensen model 26 pump jack and gasoline engine, thence through a distribution system to a 3,000 gallon storage tank and troughs where 300 head of cattle and 2000 sheep water within in the SE¼ NW¼ of Section 16, T.29N., R.60E., M.D.B.&M., being within the Valley Mountain grazing Allotment.


**This certificate changes the point of diversion, manner and place of use of Permit 43475, Certificate 11313; therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 43475, Certificate 11313.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
