

THE STATE OF NEVADA**CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, Michael Casey, Permittee, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Bernice Spring and hand dug reservoir for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 30, T.22N., R.38E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the NW corner of Section 19, T.22N., R.38E., M.D.B. & M., bears N. 26°10' W., a distance of 9,649 feet situated in Churchill County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Source:	Bernice Spring
Manner of use:	Stockwater
Amount of appropriation:	0.031 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 1,000 head of cattle but not to exceed 22.4 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st through December 31st of each year.
Date of priority of appropriation:	July 29, 2011

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

The natural discharge from Bernice Spring flows into a hand dug reservoir where 1,000 head of cattle water within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 30, T.22N., R.38E., M.D.B. & M., being within the Cow Canyon Grazing Allotment.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.



The issuance of this certificate corrects the permitted place of use.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
