CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, George G. Lindesmith, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 23, T.16N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 23, bears S. 24°44'15" W., a distance of 3,824.09 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Source:	Underground
Manner of use:	Irrigation
Amount of appropriation:	0.0784 c.f.s., but not to exceed 4.04 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st through December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	*June 21, 1973

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 240 feet deep, 6-inch diameter casing, equipped with a 3 H.P. Franklin motor, pump and totalizing meter, thence through a distribution system for sprinkler irrigation of 1.01 acres of pasture grass located within portions of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ (0.85 acres) and SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ (0.16 acres) Section 23, T.16N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., being further described as a portion of Assessor's Parcel Number 055-287-13, Washoe County, Nevada.


***This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of Permit 74315, which changed the point of diversion of Permit 73181, which changed the manner and place of use of a portion of Permit 27565, Certificate 9459; therefore, the**

date of priority remains the same as Permit 27565,
Certificate 9459.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit
with the understanding that the total annual duty of water
shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated
from all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can
be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the
use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
