

**STATE OF NEVADA****CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

**WHEREAS**, Ross E. de Lipkau, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

**NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> Section 25, T.14N., R.25E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W 1/4 corner of said Section 25 bears N. 89°02'09" W., a distance of 1,730.53 feet situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.**

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

**Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 510 feet deep, 16-inch diameter casing, equipped with a 125 H.P. U.S. Electric motor, Goulds pump and totalizing meter, thence through a distribution system for flood irrigation of alfalfa within the following land:**

40.00 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 25, T.14N., R.25E., M.D.B.&M.  
39.73 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 25, T.14N., R.25E., M.D.B.&M.  
40.00 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 25, T.14N., R.25E., M.D.B.&M.  
38.12 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 25, T.14N., R.25E., M.D.B.&M.  
16.40 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 25, T.14N., R.25E., M.D.B.&M.  
17.94 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 25, T.14N., R.25E., M.D.B.&M.  
40.00 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 36, T.14N., R.25E., M.D.B.&M.  
36.25 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 36, T.14N., R.25E., M.D.B.&M.  
20.00 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 36, T.14N., R.25E., M.D.B.&M.  
288.44 acres total

being further described as a portion of Assessor's Parcel Number 014-241-44, Lyon County, Nevada.

\*This certificate reduces the permitted duty to the consumptive use amount of 77.5 acre-feet with 22.5 acre-feet returning to the groundwater source. This certificate amends the terms of the permit to allow use of the water anywhere within the above-described place of use as described in the application and illustrated on the supporting map.


\*The water under Permit 70229, Certificate 19215; Permit 70230, Certificate 19216; and Permit 71092, Certificate 19217 is commingled and the total combined duty of water shall not exceed 232.89 acre-feet annually for the irrigation of 288.44 acres within the above-described place of use.

\*This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and is issued as a supplemental water supply to lands that have surface water rights from "Claim 66" (Grulli, A. and M., Successor to Pacific Livestock Company, p.29) of the Walker River Decree as set forth in "The United States of America, Plaintiff, v. Walker River Irrigation District et al, Defendants, in the United States District Court for the District of Nevada, Case in Equity, C-125", and any other surface water rights from the Walker River, decreed or otherwise that may be appurtenant and provided by the Walker River Irrigation District. The permit holder is responsible for insuring delivery of the decreed and/or storage rights that this permit supplements. In any year that the Federal Water Master declares a full allocation of decreed waters to the priority years of the Walker River claim(s) that this permit supplements, underground water shall not be pumped from the well described under this certificate. In any year that the Federal Water Master has no decreed water, or declares a reduced allocation of Walker River water, and the Walker River Irrigation District has no storage water, or declares a reduced allocation of storage water, then the place of use under this permit can be irrigated with underground water to the extent that Walker River and storage water is not available, but not to exceed four (4.0) acre-feet per acre annually of land irrigated from all sources.

**\*\*This certificate changes the point of diversion, Manner and place of use of a portion of Permit 30992, Certificate 9832; therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 30992, Certificate 9832.**

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
