CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, William A. Nisbet, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Honeyman Pond for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 10, T.34N., R.62E., M.D.B.& M., or at a point from which the E $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 10 bears S. 68°39'00" E., a distance of 553.30 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Source:	Honeyman Pond
Manner of use:	Stockwater
Amount of appropriation:	0.0188 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 600 head of cattle, but not to exceed 13.44 acre-feet annually.
Period of use:	January 1st through December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	April 26, 1979

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a pond that seasonally impounds water where 600 head of cattle water within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 10, T.34N., R.62E., M.D.B.& M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
