

**STATE OF NEVADA****CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

**WHEREAS**, Mary Crawley, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from effluent, through South Truckee Meadows Wastewater Treatment Plant, Huffaker Reservoir and effluent reuse distribution system for municipal (irrigation of greenbelt and common areas) purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

**SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 4, T.18N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 4 bears N. 57°24'41" W., a distance of 3,050.064 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.**

**Under the provisions of NRS 533.425**, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

**Effluent from the South Truckee Meadows Wastewater Treatment Plant is pumped from Huffaker Reservoir through an effluent reuse distribution system for irrigation of landscaped areas within the Double Diamond/South Reno area within the S $\frac{1}{2}$ , SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  and a portion of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 4; the E $\frac{1}{2}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , SE $\frac{1}{4}$  and portions of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , and the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section**

5; the E $\frac{1}{2}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , E $\frac{1}{2}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  and portions of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  and the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 8; Section 9; the N $\frac{1}{2}$ , NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  portions of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  and NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 16; the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  portions of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  and the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 17, all in T.18N., R.20E., M.D.B&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the availability of effluent by the provider and terminates when that availability ceases and is further subject to the terms stated in the Stipulation Agreement filed in the Office of the State Engineer on February 13, 1992, between Washoe County and the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe of Indians.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
