CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Stephen Pluemer, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for mining and milling purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 26, T.28N., R.45E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of Section 36 T.28N., R.45E., M.D.B.&M., bears S. 31°48'56" E., a distance of 11,204.0 feet situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Source:	Underground (West Well)
Manner of use:	Mining and Milling
Amount of appropriation:	*0.222 c.f.s., but not to exceed 97.26 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st through December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	**October 8, 1975

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 310 feet deep, 8-inch diameter casing, equipped with a 15 H.P. Franklin submersible pump and totalizing meter, thence through a distribution system for mining and milling purposes, including dust suppression, at Greystone Mine, located within Section 25, E $\frac{1}{2}$ Section 26, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 35 and N $\frac{1}{2}$ Section 36 T.28N., R.45E., M.D.B.&M., and Lots 1, 2, 3, 4 and the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 30 and Lots 1, 2 and the E $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 31, T.28N., R.46E., M.D.B.&M.


*The total combined duty of water under Permit 17654, Certificate 5250; Permit 26872, Certificate 8431; Permit 29694, Certificate 9087; Permit 35814, Certificate 10284; Permit 64260, Certificate 17458; Permit 64261, Certificate 17459; Permit 79547, Certificate 19181; Permit 80789, Certificate 19338 and Permit 81822 shall not exceed 1,076.11 acre-feet annually.

**This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 29694, Certificate 9087; therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 29694, Certificate 9087.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
