

STATE OF NEVADA**CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, Michael D. Buschelman, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Perkins Spring for wildlife purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE¹/₄ NE¹/₄ Section 1, T.19S., R.69E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of Section 6, T.17S., R.69E., M.D.B.&M., bears N. 25°10' W., a distance of 64,353 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

The discharge from Perkins Spring flows in the natural channel for wildlife and riparian habitat preservation within the NE¹/₄ NE¹/₄ Section 1, T.19S., R.69E., M.D.B.&M.

***This certificate changes the manner of use of Proof V02345; therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Proof V02345.**

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and specifically subject to the terms of any order in the matter of determination of the relative rights in and to the waters of Perkins Spring.
