CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Robert E. Morley, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 16, T.34N., R.45E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 16 bears S. 15°22'00" E., a distance of 2,649.50 feet situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Manner of use:	Irrigation
Amount of appropriation:	*0.43 c.f.s., but not to exceed 133.4 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st through December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	**May 5, 1966

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 380 feet deep, 12-inch diameter casing, equipped with a 125 H.P. General Electric motor, Byron Jackson pump and totalizing meter, thence through a distribution system for pivot and fix-set sprinkler irrigation of 33.35 acres of oats located within a portion of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 16, T.34N., R.45E., M.D.B.&M., being further described as a portion of Assessor's parcel Number 010-100-17, Lander County, Nevada.


*The water under Permit 27129, Certificate 8111; Permit 31144, Certificate 12058; Permit 59675, Certificate 19436; and Permit 80896, Certificate 19438, is commingled and the total combined duty shall not exceed 1,064.2 acre-feet annually for the irrigation of 266.05.

**This certificate changes the point of diversion of a portion of Permit 27129, Certificate 8111, which changed the point of diversion of Permit 23125; therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 23125.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit with the understanding that the total annual duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
