

STATE OF NEVADA**CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, Don Springmeyer, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from the Truckee River, through Derby Dam, the natural channel and Pyramid Lake for recreation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 17 (Projected), T.23N., R.23E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of Section 16, T.23N., R.23E., M.D.B.&M., bears N. 79°04'34" E., a distance of 7,616.79 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator:	Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe
Source:	Truckee River
Manner of use:	Recreation
Amount of appropriation:	*3,000 c.f.s., but not to exceed 477,851 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st through December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	May 25, 1984

Description of the works of diversion manner and place of use:


Water flows in the natural channel of the Truckee River for recreation purposes from Derby Dam downstream to and including Pyramid Lake, Washoe and Storey Counties, Nevada.

***The total combined duty of water under Permit 48061, Certificate 19467 and Permit 48494, Certificate 19468 shall not exceed 477,851 acre-feet annually.**

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
