

STATE OF NEVADA**CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, Bruce R. Scott, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well (Well #49), pump and distribution system for municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE¼ SW¼ Section 17, T.15N., R.20E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 17 bears S. 74°36' W., a distance of 1,998 feet situated in Carson City, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Manner of use:	Municipal
Amount of appropriation:	*0.05 c.f.s., but not to exceed 2.07 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st through December 31st of each year
Date of priority of Appropriation:	**March 31, 2006

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 776 feet deep, 36-inch diameter casing, equipped with an Iron Eagle pump, 125 H.P. Franklin motor and totalizing meter, thence through a distribution system to Carson City's water customers within the place of use approved under the permit as depicted by record (map and legal description), which is filed in the Office of the State Engineer; otherwise known as the Carson City Service Area as it existed at the time of filing of Application 68758.

*The total combined duty of water under Carson City's underground municipal permits within the Eagle Valley Hydrographic Basin (104) consisting of Permit 23672, Certificate 6471; Permit 23673, Certificate 6472; Permit 24986, Certificate 7366; Permit 25667, Certificate 9866; Permit 26581, Certificate 9622; Permit 26582, Certificate 9623; Permit 27314, Certificate 9871; Permit 27320, Certificate 9872; Permit 29002, Certificate 9904; Permit 29906, Certificate 9635; Permit 30441, Certificate 9878; Permits 36083, 36084, 47704, 48542 and 59226; Permit 59827, Certificate 19474; Permits 60831, 60832, 60833, 60834, 61487, 61505, 61506, 61507, 61508 and 66708; Permit 66709, Certificate 19475; Permit 68758, Certificate 19470; Permit 69344, Certificate 19472; Permit 69346, Certificate 19473; Permit 70521, Certificate 19476; Permits 70522 and 70662; Permit 71678, Certificate 19477; Permit 71749, Certificate 19478; and Permits 77667, 77668, 77669, 78371, 79653, 79717, 80166, 80677, 81106 81107 and 81933 shall not exceed 6,716.3 acre-feet annually. Permits 61505 through 61508 were issued for drought conditions only, per State Engineer's Order 1140, and are not additive to the above total combined duty term amount.


*The total amount of water that may be diverted from the well under Permit 68758, Certificate 19470; Permit 68759, Certificate 19471; Permit 69344, Certificate 19472; Permit 69346, Certificate 19473 and Permit 80677 shall not exceed 973.16 acre-feet annually.

**This certificate changes the point of diversion, manner and place of use of Permit 27463, Certificate 9071. The date of priority was established in accordance with NRS 533.395(3) by the cancellation rescission hearing of May 25, 2007 under Permit 68758.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
