

THE STATE OF NEVADA**CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, Sam E. Monteleone, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from South Spring, through a spring box, pipeline and trough for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE¼ SE¼ Section 9, T.36N., R.30E., M.D.B.& M., (unsurveyed) or at a point from which the NW corner of Section 6, T.36N., R.31E., M.D.B.&M. bears N. 65°45' E., a distance of 19,766 feet, situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator:	DeLong Ranches, Inc.
Source:	South Spring
Manner of use:	Stockwater
Amount of appropriation:	0.0007 c.f.s. to water 400 head of cattle, but not to exceed 0.51 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st through December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	August 8, 1988


Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from South Spring by a spring box, thence through 350 feet of 3/4-inch diameter poly pipe to a steel trough where 400 head of cattle water within the NE¼ SE¼ Section 9, T.36N., R.30E., M.D.B.&M., being within the Jackson Mountains Grazing Allotment.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
