

THE STATE OF NEVADA**CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, Michael A. Stanka, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Anderson Homestead Spring, pipeline and pond, for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 3, T.28N., R.40E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the NE corner of Section 27, T.29N., R.40E., bears N. 10°03'25.2" E., a distance of 10,770.99 feet, situated in Pershing County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: **Joe Saval Company, L.L.C.**

Source: **Anderson Homestead Spring**

Manner of use: **Stockwater**

Amount of appropriation: ***0.033 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 1,044 head of cattle, but not to exceed 23.39 acre-feet annually**

Period of use: **January 1st through December 31st of each year**

Date of priority of appropriation: **November 30, 2011**

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:


Water is diverted from Anderson Homestead Spring through a pipeline to a holding pond, where 1,044 head of cattle water within the S $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 34 and the S $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 35, all within T.29N., R.40E., M.D.B. & M. and the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 3, T.28N., R.40E., M.D.B. & M., being within the South Buffalo and Buffalo Valley Grazing Allotments.

*The total combined duty of water under Permit 81274, Certificate 19563; Permit 81275, Certificate 19564; Permit 81276, Certificate 19565; Permits 81277, 81278, 81349, 81350, and 81351 and Permit 81352, Certificate 19566 shall not exceed 23.39 acre-feet annually or sufficient to water 1,044 head of cattle.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
