

**STATE OF NEVADA****CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

**WHEREAS**, S. Victor, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from the Carson River, through the Williams Slough, Rosser (W), Boyd or Marquart Ditches for as decreed purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

**Williams Slough, Rosser (W), Boyd or Marquart Ditches from the right bank in the SW corner NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> Section 24, T.13N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.**

**Under the provisions of NRS 533.425**, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

**Water is diverted from the Carson River through the Williams Slough, Rosser (W), Boyd or Marquart Ditches to the Ambrosetti Pond, thence through a pump station and distribution system for wheel line and fixed sprinkler irrigation of pasture grass on the following land:**



\*This certificate changes the place of use of portions of Claims 249 and 817, Carson River Final Decree, in United States v. Alpine Land and Reservoir Co., Civil No. D-183 BRT (D. Nevada 1980); therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Claims 249 and 817.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water is as decreed, and subject to the continuing jurisdiction and regulation of the Federal Water Master and the State Engineer.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
