## CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Vivian Carvin, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

**SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 31, T.20N., R.22E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 31 bears S. 37°50' 26" E., a distance of 215.33 feet situated in Storey County, State of Nevada.**

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 900 feet deep, 16-inch diameter casing, equipped with a 300 H.P. Gould submersible pump and totalizing meter, thence through a distribution system for municipal water service for warehouse facilities, offices, a gas station and convenience store located within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 31 lying south of the Southern Pacific Railroad and Truckee River, SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 32 lying south of the Southern Pacific Railroad, S $\frac{1}{2}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 32, Section 33 lying south of the Southern Pacific Railroad, Section 34 lying south of the Southern Pacific Railroad, W $\frac{1}{2}$  Section 35 lying south of the Southern Pacific Railroad and a portion of Section 36, all in T.20N., R.22E., M.D.B.&M.; Sections 1 and 2, N $\frac{1}{2}$  and SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 3, W $\frac{1}{2}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  and NW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 5, Section 6 lying south of the Truckee River, E $\frac{1}{2}$  Section 10, Sections 11, 12, 13

and 14, NE¼ and E¼ SE¼ Section 15, Section 23 and Section 24, all in T.19N., R.22E., M.D.B.&M.; Section 31, W¼ W¼ Section 32, all in T.20N., R.23E., M.D.B.&M. and N¼ and SW¼ Section 5, Sections 6 and 7, W¼ Section 8, S¼ Section 16, Sections 17, 18, 19, 20 and 21, N¼ Section 30, N¼ Section 31 and N¼ Section 32, being all in T.19N., R.23E., M.D.B.&M.


\*The total combined duty of water under Permits 61778, 62256, 62257, 62258, 62260, 62261, 62262, 62263, 65603, 67176 and 69299, Certificate 19574 shall not exceed 2,195.29 acre-feet annually.

\*\*This certificate changes the point of diversion, manner and place of use of Permit 64573, which changed the point of diversion of Permit 57460, which changed the manner and place of use of a portion of Permit 29291, Certificate 9092; therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 29291, Certificate 9092.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
