

STATE OF NEVADA**CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, B.J. Vasey, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from the East Fork of the Carson River, through the Edna-Wilslef or Dressler Ditch for as decreed purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

Edna-Wilslef or Dressler ditch from the left bank of the East Fork of the Carson River, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 10, T.12N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use:	As Decreed
Date of priority of appropriation:	*1900

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from the East Fork of the Carson River through the Edna-Wilslef or Dressler Ditch, via a pump and 60 H.P. U.S. electric motor, thence through a distribution system for sprinkler irrigation of alfalfa on the following land:


**5.58 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 20, T.12N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M.
1.59 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 20, T.12N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M.
11.31 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 20, T.12N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M.
0.27 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 20, T.12N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M.
18.75 acres total**

***This certificate changes the place of use of a portion of Claim 257, Carson River Final Decree, in United States v. Alpine Land and Reservoir Co., Civil No. D-183 BRT (D. Nevada 1980); therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Claim 257.**

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water is as decreed, and subject to the continuing jurisdiction of the Federal Water Master and the State Engineer.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
