

STATE OF NEVADA**CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, Jamal Keshmiri, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from the Truckee River through the Last Chance Ditch for as decreed purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

Last Chance Ditch

SE¹/₄ NE¹/₄ Section 14, T.19N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of Section 13, T19N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M., bears N. 24°26' E., a distance of 1,840 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from the Truckee River through Last Chance Ditch, laterals, headgates, a pond and pump, thence through a distribution system for sprinkler irrigation of 1.925 acres of pasture grass and landscaping, and a pond, located within a portion of the SW¹/₄ NW¹/₄ Section 7, T.18N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., being further described as within a portion of Assessor's Parcel Numbers 044-270-14 and 044-270-19, Washoe County, Nevada.


***This certificate changes the manner and place of use of a portion of Permit 12494, Certificate 3650, which changed the point of diversion, manner and place of use of a portion of**

Claim 292, Truckee River Final Decree, in United States v. Orr Water Ditch Co., In Equity Docket No. A-3 (D. Nevada 1944); therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Claim No 292.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre as decreed from all sources and is subject to the continuing jurisdiction and regulation by the Federal Water Master and the State Engineer.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
