

STATE OF NEVADA**CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, Mary Jo Riley, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for commercial (mobile homes) purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 34, T.19S., R.53E., M.D.B.& M., or at a point from which the W $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 34 bears S. 7°33'00" E., a distance of 431.00 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation:	0.0063 c.f.s., but not to exceed 0.76 acre-feet annually

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:


Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 140 feet deep, 8-inch diameter casing, equipped with a submersible pump, totalizing meter and pressure tank, thence through a distribution system for commercial water service to four (4) mobile homes, a garage, small shed and associated landscaping, located within a portion of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 34, T.19S., R.53E., M.D.B.&M., being further described as Assessor's Parcel Number 29-851-15, Nye County, Nevada.

*This certificate changes the point of diversion, manner and place of use of a portion of Permit 14261, Certificate 5328, which changed the manner and place of use of Permit 11540. The date of priority was established in accordance with NRS 533.395 (3) by the cancellation rescission hearing of July 15, 2009 under Permit 57386.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
