CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined:

The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 4, T.17N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the Center $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 4, bears N. 73°29' W., a distance of 1,320 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Source:	Underground
Manner of use:	Irrigation
Amount of appropriation:	0.0983 c.f.s., but not to exceed 31.584 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1 st through December 31 st of each year
Date of priority:	May 6, 1977*

Description of the works of diversion and the manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 375 feet deep, 6-inch diameter casing, equipped with a 10 H.P. Berkley submersible pump motor and totalizing meter, thence through a distribution system for flood irrigation of 7.019 acres of pasture grass located within a portion of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 4, T.17N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., being further described as a portion of Assessor's Parcel Number 017-380-12, Washoe County, Nevada.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and specifically subject to the following terms:

This certificate is issued totally supplemental to a portion of Claims 660, 665 and 689, Truckee River Final Decree, in United States v. Orr Water Ditch Co., In Equity Docket No. A-3 (D. Nevada 1944). The permit holder is responsible for insuring delivery of the decreed rights that this certificate supplements.


Any use of water under this certificate is allowed only when the decreed surface water allocation under Claims 660, 665 and 689 is unavailable or reduced and with the understanding that the total annual duty of water shall not exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from all sources.

***This Certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 52421A02, Certificate 14630, which changed the point of diversion of Permit 49616, which changed the point of diversion a portion of Permit 31502; therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 31502.**

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
