CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined:

The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW¼ NE¼ Section 25, T.45N., R.68E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E¼ corner of said Section 25 bears S. 59°06'19" E., a distance of 2,924.11 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Owner of record: **Trout Creek Ranches, LLC**

Source: **Underground**

Manner of use: **Stockwater**

Amount of appropriation: **0.016 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 500 head of cattle, but not to exceed 11.2 acre-feet annually**

Period of use: **January 1st through December 31st of each year**

Date of priority: **January 18, 2011**


Description of the works of diversion and the manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 560 feet deep, 4½-inch diameter PVC casing, equipped with a Lorentz submersible pump powered by solar panels, thence to a 8,000-gallon storage tank and a 1,500-gallon trough where 500 head of cattle water within the NW¼ NE¼ Section 25, T.45N., R.68E., M.D.B.&M., being within the Bluff Creek Grazing Allotment.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
