

CORRECTED CERTIFICATE**STATE OF NEVADA****CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, John H. Milton III, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Spanish Basin Creek for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 36, T.33N., R.39E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of Section 20, T.33N., R.40E., M.D.B.&M. bears N.37°14'54" E., a distance of 9,384 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Source:	Spanish Basin Creek
Manner of use:	Irrigation
Amount of appropriation:	*1.8 c.f.s., but not to exceed 309.1 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st through December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	**November 26, 1910

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from Spanish Basin Creek through a 90-degree V-notch weir, thence through a series of ditches and laterals for flood irrigation of diversified pasture and on the following land:


*The total combined duty of water under Permit 66428, Certificate 19625 and Permit 66429, Certificate 19626, shall not exceed 646 acre-feet annually for the irrigation of 161.5 acres.

**This certificate changes the point of diversion and manner of use of Permit 1894; therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 1894.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit with the understanding that the total annual duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
