CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined:

The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 31, T.13N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 31 bears S. 64°52'W., a distance of 2,173 feet situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Owner of record: **U.S.D.A. Forest Service**

Source: **Underground**

Manner of use: **Recreation**

Amount of appropriation: **0.003 c.f.s., but not to exceed 1.0 acre-foot annually***

Period of use: **January 1st through December 31st of each year**

Date of priority: **February 22, 1982****

Description of the works of diversion and the manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 350 feet deep, 8-inch diameter casing, equipped with a 3 H.P. Grundfos pump, Franklin Electric motor and totalizing meter, thence through a distribution system for recreational water service to the Heavenly Valley Ski Resort located within the S $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 31, T.13N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M.


This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and specifically subject to the following terms:

***The total combined duty of water under Permit 57651, Certificate 19634; Permit 60743, Certificate 19635, and Permit 79059 shall not exceed 3.20 acre-feet annually.**

****This certificate changes the point of diversion, manner and place of use of a portion of Permit 45348; therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 45348.**

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
