CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined:

The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 34, T.19S., R.53E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 34 bears S. 21°40'16" W., a distance of 873.80 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Owner of record: **RCT, Inc.**

Source: **Underground**

Manner of use: **Commercial (storage facility)**

Amount of appropriation: **0.01 c.f.s., but not to exceed 1.0 acre-foot annually**

Period of use: **January 1st through December 31st of each year**

Date of priority: **April 21, 2006**

Description of the works of diversion and the manner and place of use:


Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 150 feet deep, 8-inch diameter casing, equipped with a 1.0 H.P. pump, totalizing meter, a pressure tank and two 5000-gallon storage tanks, thence through a distribution system for commercial water service to a storage facility with an office and associated landscaping, located within a portion of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 34, T.19S., R.53E., M.D.B.&M., being further described as Assessor's Parcel Number (APN) 029-602-10, Nye County, Nevada.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and specifically subject to the following terms:

This certificate is issued subject to the provisions of NRS 534.120(2) as a preferred use.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount that can be beneficially used and not to exceed the amount above, and is restricted for commercial purposes and to the place of use as described as APN 029-602-10, Nye County, Nevada.
