CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined:

The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW¼ NW¼ Section 29, T.19S., R.60E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 29 bears N. 44°20'15" W., a distance of 1,149 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Owner of record: H2O Holdings, LLC

Source: Underground

Manner of use: Quasi-Municipal

Amount of appropriation: 0.0095 c.f.s., but not to exceed 2.0 acre-feet annually*

Period of use: January 1st through December 31st of each year

Date of priority: September 9, 1944**

Description of the works of diversion and the manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 435 feet deep, 8-inch diameter casing, equipped with a 5 H.P. Jacuzzi submersible pump, Franklin Motor, three pressure tanks and a totalizing meter, thence through a distribution system for quasi-municipal water service to eight single family dwellings, six swimming pools and associated landscaping, located within a portion of the NW¼ NW¼ Section 29, T.19S., R.60E., M.D.B.&M., being further described as Assessor's Parcel Numbers 125-29-101-015, 125-29-101-016, 125-29-101-018, 125-29-101-019, 125-29-101-020, 125-29-101-023, 125-29-101-042 and 125-29-101-044, Clark County, Nevada.


This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and specifically subject to the following terms:

*The total combined duty of water under Revocable Permits 57518 and 57521; permit 71844, Certificate 19770; Permit 74549, Certificate 19771; Permit 74550, Certificate 19772; Permit 79481, Certificate 19773, Permit 79482, Certificate 19774 and Permit 79483, Certificate 19775 shall not exceed 20.46 acre-feet annually.

****This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 71844, which changed the point of diversion, manner and place of use of a portion of Permit 68493; which changed the point of diversion, manner and place of use of a portion of Permit 11165, Certificate 3864. Therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 11165, Certificate 3864.**

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
