

**STATE OF NEVADA****CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined:

The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

**NW¼ NW¼ Section 7, T.22S., R.59E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 7 bears N. 0°18'21" W., a distance of 769.89 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.**

Owner of record: **Las Vegas Valley Water District**  
Source: **Wheeler Camp Spring**  
Manner of use: **Wildlife**  
Amount of appropriation: **0.009 c.f.s., but not to exceed 5.99 acre-feet annually\***  
Period of use: **January 1<sup>st</sup> through December 31<sup>st</sup> of each year**  
Date of priority: **August 25, 1993**

Description of the works of diversion and the manner and place of use:

**The natural discharge from Wheeler Camp Spring (an unimproved spring) flows through the natural channel for wildlife purposes located within a portion of the NW¼ Section 7, T.22S., R.59E., M.D.B.&M., being further described as portions of Assessor's Parcel Numbers 175-07-101-001 and 175-07-201-001, Clark County, Nevada.**

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and specifically subject to the following terms:


**\*The total combined duty of water under Permit 8819, Certificate 1754; Permit 30570, Certificate 10076 and Permit 59176, Certificate 19785 shall not exceed 64.43 acre-feet annually.**

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
