CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined:

The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 36, T.19N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 36, bears S. 66°45'00" E., a distance of 2,900 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Owner of record: **Terrance W. and Linda J. Oliver**

Source: **Underground**

Manner of use: **Irrigation**

Amount of appropriation: **0.03 c.f.s., but not to exceed 10.0 acre-feet annually**

Period of use: **January 1st through December 31st of each year**

Date of priority: **February 3, 1949***

Description of the works of diversion and the manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 202 feet deep, 8-inch diameter casing, equipped with a submersible pump and totalizing meter, thence through a distribution system for sprinkler irrigation of pasture grass on the following described land to which the water is appurtenant:

**1.1 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 36, T.19N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M.
1.4 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 36, T.19N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M.
2.5 acres total**

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and specifically subject to the following terms:


This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and is totally supplemental to Truckee River Claim 208.5, Truckee River Final Decree, in United States v. Orr Water Ditch Co., In Equity Docket No. A-3 (D. Nevada 1944). In addition, in any year that the Federal Water Master declares a full allocation of decreed waters to the priority years of the Truckee River claim supplemental to this permit, underground water shall not be pumped from the well on the place of use described under this certificate. In any year that the Federal Water Master declares a reduced allocation of Truckee River Claim Water, then the place of use can be

irrigated with underground water up to the extent of the maximum decreed duty, 4.30 acre-feet per acre, of land irrigated from all sources.

*This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 70253, which changed the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 12807, Certificate 3699; therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 12807, Certificate 3699.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
