CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined:

The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 9, T.34N., R.45E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 9 bears S. 73°38'03"E., a distance of 2,421.87 feet situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

Owner of record: Erik M. Taylor and Kristine W. Taylor

Source: Underground

Manner of use: Irrigation

Amount of appropriation: 0.2 c.f.s., but not to exceed 93.40 acre-feet annually*

Period of use: January 1st through December 31st of each year

Date of priority: December 16, 1965**

Description of the works of diversion and the manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 500 feet deep, 16-inch diameter casing, equipped with a 250 H.P. General Electric motor, National vertical turbine pump and totalizing meter, thence through a distribution system for pivot sprinkler irrigation of alfalfa on the following described land to which the water is appurtenant:

2.90 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 9, T.34N., R.45E., M.D.B.&M.
3.00 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 9, T.34N., R.45E., M.D.B.&M.
2.91 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 9, T.34N., R.45E., M.D.B.&M.
2.97 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 9, T.34N., R.45E., M.D.B.&M.
2.91 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 9, T.34N., R.45E., M.D.B.&M.
3.03 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 9, T.34N., R.45E., M.D.B.&M.
2.78 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 9, T.34N., R.45E., M.D.B.&M.
<u>2.85 acres in the SE$\frac{1}{4}$ SW$\frac{1}{4}$ Section 9, T.34N., R.45E., M.D.B.&M.</u>
23.35 acres total

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and specifically subject to the following terms:


The total annual duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from all sources.

*The total combined duty of water under Permit 76909, Certificate 19417; Permit 77099, Certificate 19418; Permit 77466, Certificate 19419; Permit 77467, Certificate 19420; Permit 80322, Certificate 19421; Permit 80323, Certificate 19422; Permit 80324, Certificate 19423; Permit 80325, Certificate 19424; Permit 80326, Certificate 19425; Permit 80327, Certificate 19426; Permit 80328, Certificate 19427 and Permit 83495, Certificate 19824 shall not exceed 893.92 acre-feet annually for the irrigation of 223.48 acres.

**This certificate changes the point of diversion, manner and place of use of a portion of Permit 22891, Certificate 8056; therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 22891, Certificate 8056.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
